Mayor's summary

The **NM legislative session** is set to begin mid-January, 2024 and run for **30** days. Their primary focus will be on **budget issues**. We have put together **requests** which include the **Angel Hill water tower** and pipeline that will connect with the existing loop to the **fire hydrants** in the Village. The recent **bond election** gave us almost enough to construct **Fire Substation #3**. **Roads and drainage** are always an issue. The **Old Church interior** needs to be replastered and the municipal parking lot needs to be finished. We are hoping 2024 will be a year to **finish those projects!**

New Mexico is one of ten States that has **VERY HIGH** in **Respiratory Illness** Activity. Stay home if you are sick. **COVID 19** cases and hospitalizations in New Mexico from 12/1/2023 – 12/25/2023 was **54.21** %. All lab confirmed COVID cases were in people 49 and younger. However, **62.66**% of

all **hospitalizations** during the same time were **65 and older**. If you have not gotten your annual influenza vaccine or your 23-24 COVID booster you can still get them. Find a provider at: https://vaccine.doh.nm.gov/.
