Mayor's comments

The Balloon Fiesta takes place from **Oct.** 5th **through** 13th this year. From a small gathering of 13 balloons in 1972 held in the parking lot of Coronado Center Mall in Albuquerque, the **Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta** has grown to become the **largest balloon event in the world**. Held each year during the first week in October, the Balloon Fiesta now features about 600 balloons and 700 pilots.

Our **Public Works Director, Michael Chavez,** was recently made aware of the New Mexico Environment Department's **Liquid Waste Assistance Fund** (LWAF). This program provides support for low-income homeowners who need to **replace or repair failing septic systems** or cesspools. Funding is provided to help **cover the cost** of replacing failing systems with on-site wastewater disposal systems. It will also cover the costs associated with **connecting to a central sewer system.** Aging septic systems pose a **threat** to both **public health** and the **environment** across New Mexico.

To qualify for funding, you must **own** or be in the process of purchasing the property where repairs will occur and have **resided in the home for the past year**. The full home value (per the county assessor) must not exceed the median home value for the county in which the home is located. Applicants must meet the

program income guidelines, which vary by county and are based on HUD guidelines.

Expanded early in-person voting for the general election begins October 19, 2024. Our local Village elections are held in odd numbered years, to the next election for local officials will be held Nov. 4, 2025. Election day is Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2024. Early voting will begin Oct. 8th and close Nov. 2nd. Voter registration closes on Oct. 8th, but same-day voter registration will be available in person at any voting location during early voting as well as on Election Day. The last day to request an absentee ballot is Tuesday, Oct. 22, 2024.

County. Early voting starts Oct. 8, 2024 in the COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE 1500 Idalia Road, Bldg D, Bernalillo. Expanded Early In-person voting will begin at the Corrales COMMUNITY ENTER on Saturday, Oct. 19th. That polling location will be open Monday through Saturday from 10 AM to 6 PM until Nov. 2nd.

There will be a **joint work study** of the **council and P&Z** on **10/15 at 6 PM** to review the **comprehensive plan** before it is hopefully brought to the council for **approval in November.** There will also be a **public meeting** for **public input** sometime around that date, at a time and place to be determined. This combined meeting/review will be **available on ZOOM** since it will be in council chambers.
